General Criteria

Order materials on languages taught at UTPA: Spanish, French, German, Chinese, Japanese, and Portuguese. Priority shall be given to those languages taught during the academic year and as recommended by the instructors. Limited materials may be purchased for languages not taught during the academic year. Materials in other languages may be ordered in translation or in the original language as requested by the department.

1. **Spanish Language:** (Dr. Martinez)  
All material undergraduate and graduate levels
  - A. **Spanish literature** Books written by and about Spanish authors, including criticism, and books written about Spanish literature and civilization.
  - B. **Spanish-American literature** Books written by and about Spanish-American authors, including criticism, and books written about Spanish-American literature and civilization.
  - C. **Spanish language and linguistics** Books written about the Spanish language and Spanish linguistics including

teaching the Spanish language, and about second language teaching and bilingualism

**D. Faculty research needs**

2. **French language** (Dr. Behar)

All material undergraduate level

A. **French literature and culture** Books written by and about French authors, including criticism, and books written about French literature and civilization.

All material undergraduate level

A. **German language and linguistics** Books written for teaching the German language, and books written about German linguistics.
