

## **COLLECTION DEVELOPMENT CRITERIA**

**SUBJECT AREA:** Rehabilitative Service  
**ACADEMIC YEAR:** 2009-2010

**PURPOSE:** The purpose is to select and maintain a well-balanced collection that will support educational and research needs of rehabilitative service students and faculty.

### **GENERAL CRITERIA:**

**LANGUAGE:** English is the primary language of the collection. Works originally written in a language other than English will be purchased selectively and usually in English translation.

**DATE OF PUBLICATIONS:** Emphasis is on current publications (last five years). Older works are rarely purchased and are generally added to the collection only when they illustrate a specific teaching or research need of students and faculty.

**FORMAT OF MATERIALS:** Any material that meets the criteria of the rehab service collection will be purchased, regardless of format.

**TYPES OF MATERIAL:** Included are encyclopedias, directories, dictionaries, proceedings of rehab service institutes and conferences, theses and dissertations from other institutions. Pertinent local, state, and federal government documents will be acquired, as will the publications of major national organizations in the field including:

National Rehabilitation Association  
National Council on Rehabilitation Education
